You have expressed an interest in joining a long tradition of local volunteers that drive what many folks around here call "the Cancer Bus". Friends of Florence (FoF) helps local cancer patients with one of the most difficult parts of their radiation therapy - the 150-mile daily round trip drive to treatments in the Willamette Valley. This transportation is free and available Mon - Fri, 52 weeks a year, and has been since May of 1986.

Every volunteer driver is expected to drive one or two days a month, with each round trip lasting from about 7:30 am to 12:30 pm. Drivers follow an established travel route to our two stops, and commit to giving our riders **safe**, **smooth**, and **comfortable** experience. We drive carefully and courteously: for the riders that may be feeling sick and vulnerable due to their cancer treatments, and because every time we get behind the wheel of the Friends of Florence van, we are representing this organization and the hundreds of volunteer drivers that have come before us.

The first step to becoming an FoF driver is to fill out the attached/enclosed Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) request form. If you would like to pursue this opportunity, please complete this form and the MVR request form and mail it to: Friends of Florence, PO Box 598, Florence OR, 97439. We use the MVR form as a background check for all potential drivers. Our insurance company, currently Zolezzi Insurance Agency, will process the form.

Once we are notified you are cleared to drive with us, one of our driver trainers will contact you with training information, to answer your questions, and to schedule training dates.
